In order to receive a diploma of graduation from Enochs High School students must:

1. Pass a minimum of 230 units.
2. Pass required core courses.
3. Meet the District Computer Literacy requirement.
4. Pass the California State High School Exit Exam.

Class Prerequisites

Prerequisites are the requirements students must meet prior to placement in certain classes. The following prerequisites are required for entrance into College Prep, Pre-AP and AP classes:

Pre-AP/HG English 1-2	9th	Recommendation of 8th grade English teacher, and a grade of "B" or higher, teacher recommendation, and completion of summer reading/writing assignments; meets District CST Incentive Plan
Pre-AP/ HG English	10th	Pre-AP English 1-2 or CP 1-2 with "C" or higher, teacher recommendation, or a 3 or higher on the AP Lang test, completion of summer reading/writing assignments; meets District CST Incentive Plan
CP English 1-2	9th	Recommendation of 8th grade English teacher pending on-site high school assessment
CP English 3-4	10th	Recommendation of 9th grade English teacher, and a grade of at least a "C" or higher; meets District CST Incentive Plan
Pre-AP Geometry	9th	Algebra with grade of "A" or "B" and Geometry Readiness Test 32 or higher.
Pre-AP Advanced Algebra	9th-10th	Pre-AP Geometry with a "C" or higher and Algebra II Readiness Test 32 or higher; meets District CST Incentive Plan
Algebra	9th	Pre-Algebra, score of 32 and above on Algebra Readiness Test, and teacher recommendation
Algebra	10th-12th	Algebra Essentials 4 with grade of "A" and 90% Mastery Test; or Algebra Essentials 6 with a grade of "C" or higher; meets District CST Incentive Plan
Geometry	9th	Geometry Readiness Test 32 or higher
Geometry	10th-12th	Algebra w/grade of "C" or higher; meets District CST Incentive Plan
Advanced Algebra	9th-12th	Geometry w/grade of "C" or higher; meets District CST Incentive Plan
Pre-Calculus	11th-12th	Advanced Algebra with "C" or higher; meets District CST Incentive Plan
CP Biology	10th-11th	CP Earth Science with a "C" or higher and a completion of or concurrent enrollment in Algebra (Earth Science to CP Biology requires teacher recommendation); meets District CST Incentive Plan
CP Chemistry	11th	CP Biology and Algebra with "C" or higher in both; meets District CST Incentive Plan
CP Earth Science	9th	Pre-Algebra and/or "C" or higher in physical science
AP European History	10th	Pre-AP English 1-2 or CP English 1-2, teacher recommendation, and concurrent enrollment in Pre-AP English 3-4, or CP English 3-4; meets District CST Incentive Plan

California Standards Tests (CST) Incentive Plan

For current 9th, 10th, or 11th grade students to continue in a College Prep, Pre-AP, or AP class, they must meet minimum performance levels on the California Standards Test for that subject area. For instance, a 10th grade student who wants to continue with College Prep English in the 11th grade must meet the performance level required by the incentive plan on the 10th grade English California Standards Test.
