What are Advanced Placement courses?

- College-level courses taken in High School: year long course in HS vs. semester in college
- College-level academic knowledge
- College-level output expectations
- AP Exams taken in May (\$87/per)



2009-2010 AP Exams at EHS

- 222 Students
- 382 AP exams
- 14 different subjects



Advantages of Advanced Placement

- Gain an edge in college preparation, earn college credits while still in High School (amount of credit varies from college to college)
- Develop college-level study habits
- Show potential colleges your commitment to academic excellence
- Flexibility for students to pursue their individual strengths



Pre-requisites for Advanced Placement Courses

- “B” or higher in previous College Prep or Pre AP level course
- Strong curiosity about the subject and willingness to work hard
- Proven work ethic with students completing all assigned work
